St Matthew's is a Diocesan School and we look forward to welcoming them to their Cathedral.

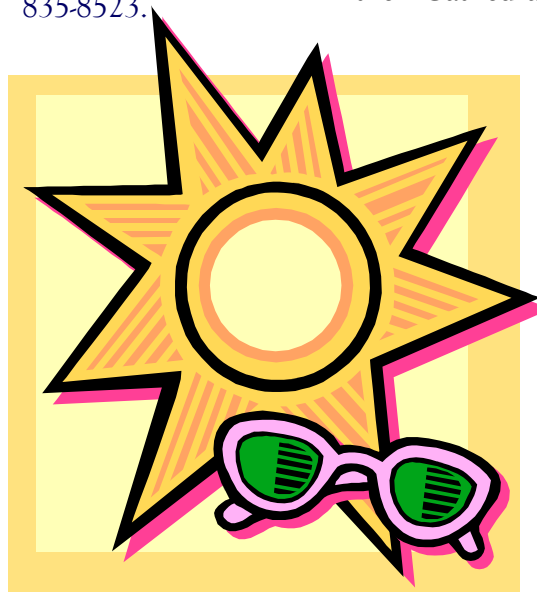


Waitangi Day
