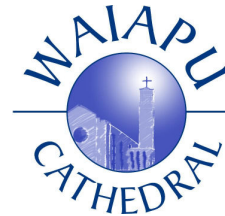
A pastoral companion will be present to keep you company, or leave you in peace.

AGM

Our AGM will be **Sunday 30 May**. Elections will be held for Vestry members (up to 10), Cathedral Chapter (2, elected for a 3 year term) and Synod Rep (1 elected for a 2 year term), and People's Warden (1 elected every year).

Vestry has general oversight of the day to day running of the parish; Chapter does the big picture, long term planning and mission of the Cathedral. The Synod rep attends the annual Diocesan Synod on behalf of the parish.

Nominations will close **Sunday 23 May**, please pray about who should be our leaders for the next year. Complete a nomination form and return to the Office.

Reports for the AGM need to be in by **9 May**. Any parish group can provide a report, a good chance to take stock and to record our activities.

Our **Patronal Festival Service** on Thursday will include the **dedication of an aumbry** in memory of Nola Moroney. An aumbry is a small cupboard where consecrated bread, wine and oils are kept between services and for home communions. Nola left a bequest, some of which has been used to purchase the aumbry. It has been made for us by Don Alexander who also made the candle stands and new lectern.

GENERAL SYNOD

The 59th session of the General Synod/Te Hinota Whanui begins in Gisborne on Saturday 8th May and will continue through the following week. The Anglican Covenant will be a major topic for discussion - in houses (bishops, clergy, and lay) and tikanga (Maori, Pakeha, and Polynesia), and in plenary sessions. It is also hoped to announce the new Bishop of Polynesia following their electoral Synod in Suva on 29th April.
