SIGNIFICANT DATES CONCERNING BISHOP DAVID IN SAN JOAQUIN

23rd February - Bishop David will be making his 'Oath of Conformity' whereby he becomes a Bishop in the Episcopal Church, USA. This will take place at St Paul's Episcopal Church, Modesto. The Episcopal Church Presiding Bishop Katharine Jefferts Schori will be presiding and bishops from Province VIII, of which San Joaquin is a part, will be in attendance.

29th March at the conclusion of the special convention Bishop David will be seated (installed) as Provisional Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of San Joaquin at St Paul's Episcopal Church, Bakersfield, USA.

The Waiapu Vicar-General, the Reverend Brian Hamilton, will represent the Waiapu Diocese at the service on the 29th March, and Archbishop Philip Richardson will also attend. 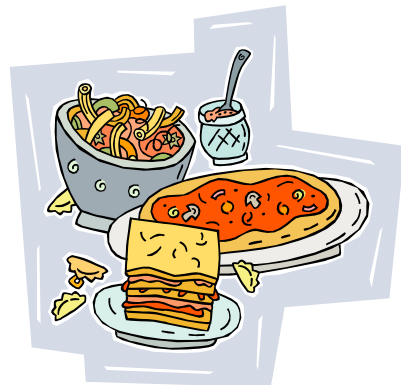
