And at 5.00 pm on **Sunday** evenings, Murray Mills leads a study series based on a dvd with the theme of betrayal, crucifixion and resurrection - presented by Tim Barlow "***Lent and Easter in Art***".

- ⊙ are concerned that parishioner giving has fallen behind budget and ask parishioners to do their best to complete their pledges by 31 March 2011.

## Bishop David introduces Cursillo 2011

In April and May the Diocese of Wellington will be gifting **Cursillo** to Waiapu. Cursillo is the worldwide, lay-led movement within the Anglican Church which has enlivened the faith of many throughout our communion.

From the **28th April to 1st May**, a women's gathering will be held at Lindisfarne College, Hastings, and the **19th to 22nd May** will be the men's weekend at Riverbend in Hawke's Bay.
