EASTER MORNING BROADCAST

An hour-long service of Easter readings and music was recorded in the Cathedral recently and was broadcast on Radio NZ National this morning at 7am in place of the usual hymn programme.

If you missed the 7am broadcast this morning on Radio NZ National, it will be repeated at 11pm tonight.

An unveiling service for the **Rev'd Dr Hone Kaa**, a priest of this diocese, ordained in this cathedral, and formerly Vicar of Porangahau, was held in Rangitukia yesterday. A tribute from Bishop John was read at this service.

On Easter Sunday morning, after the 8am service at the Cathedral, **Bishop John** will be travelling to Waipawa to preach and preside at St Peter's - his Easter sermon will be available on the Cathedral website later this week.

Rev'd Dorothy Brooker is at St Augustine's this morning; **Rev'd Jon Williams** is at Ormond Chapel; **Rev'd Howard Pilgrim** has his final service as Priest-in-charge at St Matthew's Parish, Hastings, this morning; and welcome home to **Rev'd Graeme Pilgrim!**
