Our thoughts and prayers are with our tikanga Maori partners as they mourn the loss of **HONE KAA**. Archdeacon of Tamaki Makaurau and well-known child advocate Dr Hone Kaa had been sick for some time, and died at Auckland Hospital on Thursday. His body was taken to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Auckland on Friday, before going to Rangitukia (East Coast) for burial next week. As Anglican Archdeacon of Tamaki Makaurau, Dr Kaa oversaw the two Auckland pastorates; he was also a senior lecturer at Te Rau Kahikatea Theological College in St John's, Auckland. He was instrumental in supporting initiatives to advance Maori education and the protection of children and their families. He also served as a member and spokesman for the child advocacy group Every Child Counts, established in 2005 with the aim of seeing children placed at the centre of government policy and planning.

JOIN THE JOURNEY PALM SUNDAY TO EASTER DAY



Palm Sunday – 1st April – at 9.30 am, we gather at the Sound-shell on Marine Parade then follow the donkey in procession, waving palm branches, to the Cathedral; at 10.00 am, the Parish Eucharist includes the telling of the story of Holy Week; and at 12 noon, a Baptism at Pandora Pond.

Holy Week – Monday 2nd, Tuesday 3rd, Wednesday 4th April – 7.00 am Eucharist in the Maori Chapel

Wednesday 4th April – at 11.00 am, Bishop David Rice presides at the Blessing of Oils and Renewal of Ordination Vows service – all welcome.

Maundy Thursday 5th April – at 7.00 pm, the Maundy Thursday Eucharist, also with an opportunity for participating in the foot-washing ceremony

Good Friday 6th April – at 9.30 am, the Good Friday service (particularly for families and children); at 10.30 am, we join the other Napier Inner-City Churches for a brief service gathered around our Memorial Cross;

Good Friday 6th April – at 12 noon, we commence the three-hour Vigil based on *“The Seven Last Words of our Saviour from the Cross”* with music composed by Joseph Haydn played by a string quartet

Good Friday 6th April – at 7.00 pm, the Cathedral Choir present a recital of music and songs for Holy Week *“Stations of the Cross”*, utilising the space of the Cathedral to present a variety of settings.

Holy Saturday 7th April – at 7.00 pm, Bishop David Rice will preside at the Service of New Fire, and Confirmations – we have five young people to be confirmed, so come along and support them in this significant event in the faith journey.

Easter Day 8th April – at 8.00 am, Eucharist with Easter hymns; *at 9.00am (at Ormond Chapel), Easter Day Family Eucharist*; and at 10.00 am, Bishop David Rice preaches and presides at the Easter Day Choral Eucharist service, with choir and orchestra.

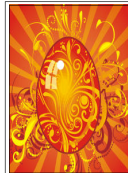
