## NO CATHEDRAL SERVICES next Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> April

**Next Sunday will be different.** Because the cathedral will be taken over by the furniture, rehearsals and performances of the Napier Civic Choir for the weekend, our **8am Eucharist** will be held in the other church in the parish, **Ormond Chapel on Napier Terrace.**

The **10am Eucharist**, originally planned as a bi-cultural service with the Maori Mission and St Augustine's, will now be a shared service hosted by the St Augustine's Parish and held in **St Augustine's Church, corner Latham St & Riverbend Rd** where the Rev'd Dorothy Brooker will preside. Bishop John will preach at both services.

## ORGAN

Our organ festival takes a breather for a while, at least until the **19<sup>th</sup> May** when **Martin and Jenny Setchell** present a recital of organ works plus a presentation on the organs of Christchurch affected by the earthquakes. Martin Setchell will also be guest organist for the 10am Choral Eucharist on 19<sup>th</sup> May.
