### Congratulations to ...

**Matthew West** who graduated as a Royal NZ Air Force pilot in a ceremony at Ohakea Air-base on Friday 20 April;

**Robin Gwynn** who has recently be appointed to the Roll of Distinguished Philatelists.

The Roll of Distinguished Philatelists was established in 1921 by the Philatelic Congress of Great Britain with the approval of His Majesty King George V, who was the first Signatory. An invitation to sign the Roll is regarded as the world’s pre-eminent philatelic honour. 356 philatelists from 38 countries have achieved this distinction; there are currently 75 signatories from 24 countries (17 from Great Britain, 10 from USA, 6 from France, 5 from Germany, 4 from Italy and 4 from Switzerland).

At a recent meeting of the Board of Election, the members unanimously decided to ask Robin Gwynn (NZ), Jamie Gough (USA), Patrick Maselis (Belguim) and Michael Sefi (UK) to sign the Roll.

The Signing Ceremony will take place on Sunday 21 October at St John’s Kirk, Perth (Scotland) during the 2012 Philatelic Congress of Great Britain.
