Mount Maunganui is a medium-sized parish with two worship centres - St Peter's, and St Mary's which is adjacent to Bayfair shopping centre. The parish has a strong ethos of community involvement and support. All services have strong lay involvement and regularly include visitors.

St Peter's is also developing its music returning to a more traditional higher Anglican style of worship with robed choir, acolytes, and sung Eucharist. There are two childcare centres, *Growing Through Grief* and a range of programmes for children. The parish complex is well used by community groups and the church has many social events during the year for families, for men and women. Parish highlights include the Saints & Angels street party (alternative to Halloween); and Pet Sunday in October

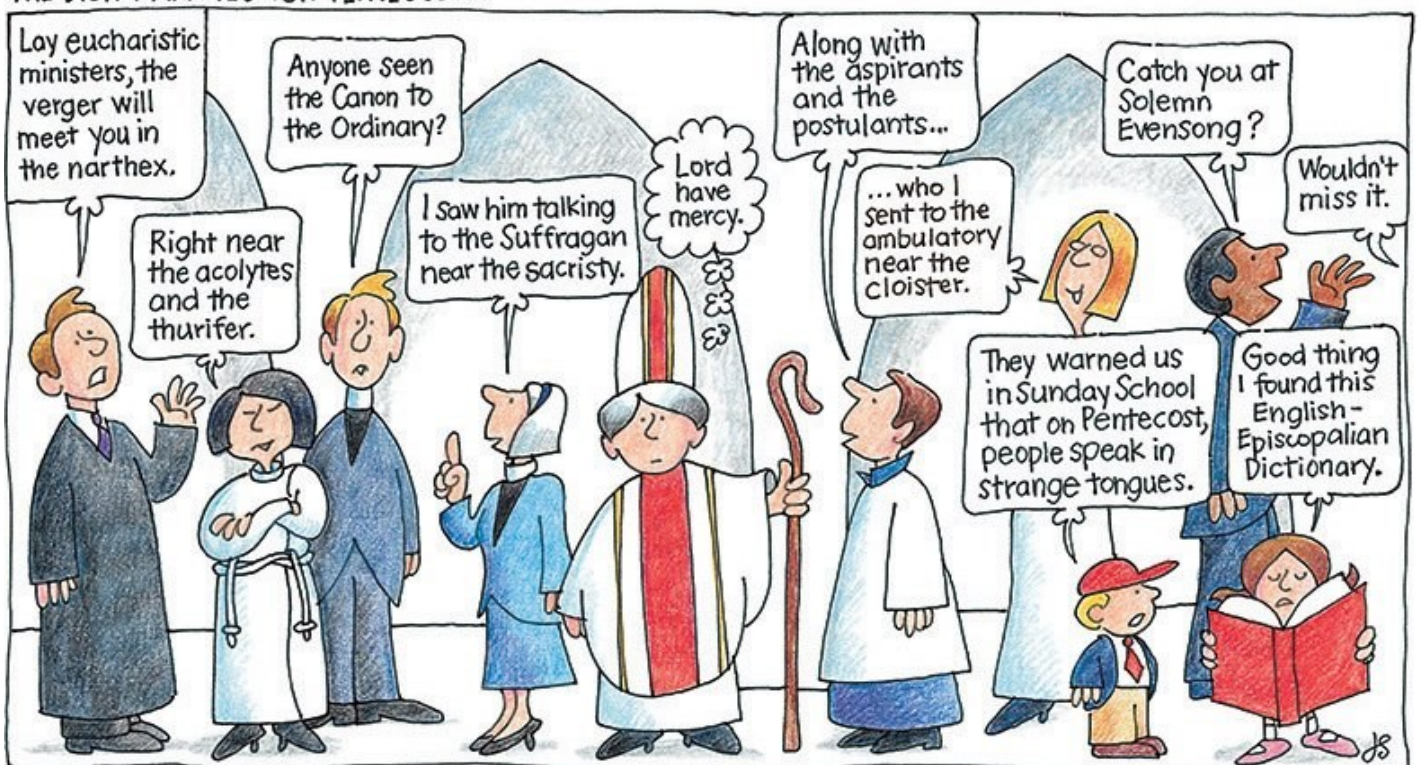
