Vestry met last week and ...

- ❖ reviewed the draft financial statements for 2011-12 and were pleased to see last year's giving had kept to our budget;
- ❖ agreed to the replacement of the squabs in the Cathedral pews (or maybe the front half). To do all pews will cost approx \$16,000. Donations are welcome!
- ❖ looked at concept plans for the renovation of the kitchen and vestry (next to the Parish Office) and this will be done later in the year, budget allowing (approx \$25,000);
- ❖ looked at concept plans for additional toilets in the foyer and a renovated entrance way. This is a major project and needs further work to assess what other upgrades (eg fire protection) will be triggered by a building consent;
- ❖ are pleased to announce that Basil Brooker is taking on a (voluntary) role as Cathedral Events Coordinator to help us manage the many concerts that happen in the Cathedral. This role will also oversee some of the minor maintenance work that is always needing to be done.
