ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Notice is given that the AGM of the Cathedral Parish will be held next **Sunday 26 June 2011, following the 10.00 am Choral Eucharist service in the Cathedral.** A booklet of reports received so far is available from the back table this morning ... please read and share and bring with you to the AGM next Sunday. We have not yet received the Financial Reports from the Diocesan Office - we hope to have this, and other late reports, available next week.

Last chance today (before the AGM) to review your details we hold on the **Parish Roll** as we compile a new "Electoral" roll as required by the Diocesan Canons, ie each parish is required to maintain two rolls - one a "**Pastoral**" roll for the purpose of mission and outreach, and lists those who are voluntarily associated with the parish, irrespective of age or baptism; the second is an "**Electoral**" roll for voting purposes. This roll consists of baptized parishioners who have participated in worship and parish life for the last four months. Only those who have enrolled on the electoral roll shall be entitled to vote at parish meetings.

Please check your entry, tick if correct and indicate if you wish to be on electoral roll; for changes or new entries fill in a roll card; please also include your email address if applicable.
