WETLANDS PLANTING Sunday 15 July, 2.00 pm

As a follow up to this year's Civic Service at St Paul's Presbyterian Church on the theme of "**Our Wetlands**", the Hawke's Bay Regional Council invite members and friends of the Inner City Covenant Churches to a planting at **Harakeke Waterway Enhancement Project.**

The plants have been brought by the Regional Council with the offering received at the Civic Service. Patrick Whitesell, the stream engineer who designed the project, will be the HBRC representative present on the day. And Jenny O'Sullivan, from Te Mara Nursery will be present to assist and supervise as well. Te Mara Nursery have been responsible for supplying and planting many of the plants present and will be supplying and preparing the site for this planting.

The program for the afternoon: Staff will be present between 2pm – 3.30pm. 200 native plants will be onsite with 200 holes pre dug. Parishioners can arrive from 2pm to



plant a native tree (or 5) and have a chat to Patrick and Jenny about the project, the vision for the area and some of challenges associated with this work.

Parking: Participants will need to park on either Nuffield Ave, Williams Street or Nash Street and make the short walk to the planting area as indicated on the attached map.

Wet weather: In the event of a wet day, Patrick Whitesell will make the call on postponement. If wet, the suggested postponement date is the 29th July. The Rev'd Sally Carter (St Paul's) is co-ordinating the churches involvement.
