### Today we celebrate and give thanks for our sister Cathedral as Christ- church's new cardboard cathedral is now officially in the hands of the Anglican Church.

Contractors handed over the keys last week and Bishop Victoria Matthews blessed the building in a special ceremony late Friday afternoon, 2 August.

Work on the structure in Latimer Square started in April last year and was plagued with a number of delays.

A judge ruled against Anglican leaders in April, deciding insurance money from the Christ Church Cathedral could not be put towards the new structure.

Then earlier this month workers had to cut away and replace warped sections of the cardboard pipes after they became sodden after heavy rain.

The transitional Anglican cathedral, which is expected to have a lifespan of more than 50 years, is designed by Japanese architect Shigeru Ba.

The public are invited back to worship in the cathedral from today, with a dedication service to be held on Thursday 15 August.
