At **4.00 pm** this afternoon, the Cathedral based Environment-Justice-Peace network meet in the Parish Lounge.

**Today we celebrate the life and work of Charles Elliot Fox, Scholar & Missionary**

He was born in England in 1878 and came to New Zealand with his parents in 1884 when his father became the Vicar of Gisborne. Charles attended high school in Napier, and played cricket against a team from Norfolk Island brought to NZ by the Bishop of Melanesia, inspiring Charles to join the Melanesian Mission. He did so in 1902 and served in various capacities for over seventy years.

He became an expert in Melanesian languages, publishing several dictionaries; he also translated the Bible and the Book of Common Prayer. During the Second World War, his work amongst the villages was legendary - he was a coast-watcher, successfully evading capture by the Japanese through his intimate knowledge of the terrain and the loyalty of the Melanesian people.

He spent his final years in New Zealand, and died on the 28th October 1977. At his own request his funeral service was held in Honiara, and he was buried at Tambalia, the home of the Melanesian Brotherhood.
