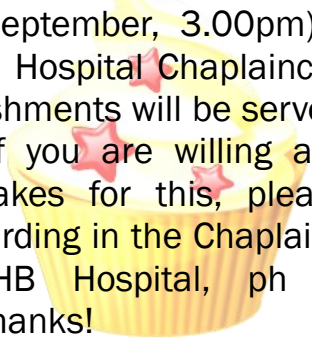
## DEANERY PANTRY
