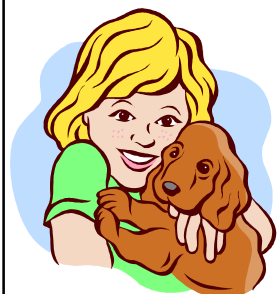

Leadership for Youth - is a new programme for young people launched at Synod. It is aimed at those 14 years and older and involves projects undertaken over two years in the five areas of mission: telling our story; faith formation; serving others; social justice; and the care of creation. A badge is awarded at the end of each module and then a Bishop of Waiapu award at the end of the two years. Each young person is accompanied by a mentor, and the young people will participate in camps and other activities as a group. Some of our young people are considering taking this on and we will launch the programme on Youth Sunday, 14 October, at the 10.00 am service.

There will be no service in December. Nau mai, haere mai; come along and worship in Te Reo Maori.

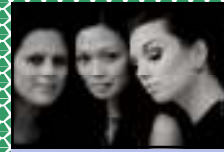
