### **DE-CONSECRATION OF ST CLARE'S CHURCH, FLAXMERE**

On **Wednesday 12 October at 4.00 pm**, Bishop David Rice will de-consecrate the Anglican Church of St Clare's in Flaxmere, as it will no longer be used for worship services. The Waiapu Board of Diocesan Trustees made the decision to sell the building to Age Concern for their community base, effective from the 30th September.

St Clare's has been the centre for an Anglican presence in the Flaxmere community for the past forty years.

### **TAMATEA CO-OPERATING CHURCH**

The Church in Tamatea has been a co-operative venture with the Anglican-Presbyterian-Methodist Churches, and for the past decade has been under Anglican oversight. In a service held last week, the oversight has now been handed over to the Presbyterian Church.

### Archbishop's wife dies suddenly

Mother Wasita Kopapa, the wife of Papua New Guinea's Archbishop Joe Kopapa, has died suddenly after a heart attack. She collapsed in Resurrection Cathedral and died at 3:30pm in Popondetta General Hospital on October 3rd. Mother Wasita was known for her quiet but determined manner and her understated efficiency. She played an integral role in supporting Archbishop Joe but also embraced her own ministry through the Mothers' Union. "She was always available with a willing hand and a ready smile," said a friend. "She had a truly generous spirit and a wonderfully welcoming heart."
