### **ONCE IN A LIFE-TIME!**

It's time to get ready for the biggest-ever Anglican gathering to hit these shores. The **Anglican Consultative Council (ACC15)** will meet in Auckland from next Saturday, 27th October until Wednesday 7th November. **EVERYONE** is invited to attend the opening ceremonial welcome at the Manukau Events Centre on **Saturday 27 October at 10.00 am**.

The ACC15 opening Eucharist will be at the **Holy Trinity Cathedral** on **Sunday 28th October at 10.00am** with the Archbishop of Canterbury preaching. Dean Helen Jacobi and Bishop Murray Mills will represent Waiapu. Due to the limited space, this is a "ticket only" entry.

And there are three public presentations, chaired by the Archbishop of Canterbury: Tues. 30 Oct, 7.30pm "Gender-based Violence"; Thurs. 1 Nov, 7.30pm "The Environment"; and Tues. 6 November, 7.30pm "Witness".

### **A letter from Dean Helen Jacobi ...**

Dear Parishioners

I write to tell you that on Tuesday 16th October, I meet with Bishop David Rice to inform him of my intention to resign as Dean of the Diocese and Vicar of the Cathedral Parish effective 31 March 2013. My last Sunday in the Cathedral will be **24 February 2013** (due to leave owing).

I will have served as Dean of the Cathedral for almost 9 years and it is time for the Cathedral to seek a new leader. The date of our departure is timed with a sabbatical which Stephen will be taking in the United States March – May 2013. Stephen is to be a Fulbright Scholar at the University of Georgetown in Washington DC where he will be undertaking a research project in his field of international trade. I have been granted a residency for part of this time at Virginia Theological Seminary and we will live at the Seminary in Alexandria.

On our return in June 2013 we will settle in either Auckland or Wellington to allow Stephen to expand his consulting business. I will then seek ministry opportunities in either city.

Our years in Hawke's Bay have been a wonderful time for us as a family. Our girls have grown up here and we have enjoyed the rhythm of life in the Cathedral community and all the Bay has to offer. We will be sad to leave but the time feels right and we know God will bring a new leader to the Cathedral. We are very sorry to be leaving before the organ project is complete and to miss the dedication service and opening recitals (mark your diaries now - April 4 and 5, 2013).

The Cathedral Chapter, Wardens and Vestry will in due course plan a process of consultation as the search for a new dean begins. In the meantime it is business as usual as we continue to serve God in this place.
