ACC15 events for Hawke's Bay next Sunday 4 November

10.00 am, at the Cathedral, guest preacher: The Right Rev'd Mwita Akiri

Bishop Mwita Akiri is the founding Bishop of the Anglican Diocese of Tarime, Tanzania. More details on Diocese of Tarime's website <http://www.anglicantarime.org/> Bishop Mwita will be in NZ attending the **Anglican Consultative Council** meeting in Auckland from 27 October-7 November.

Bishop Mwita Akiri will attend a lunch hosted by All Saints' Taradale (on behalf of the Hawke's Bay Parishes), followed by a discussion on God's mission in our part of the world. Lunch will be \$10 per person (payable on the day at Taradale, but numbers required for catering - sign-up sheet on the back table at the Cathedral).

Extracts from a letter to Parishioners from Dean Helen Jacobi ...

On Tuesday 16th October, I meet with Bishop David Rice to inform him of my intention to resign as Dean of the Diocese and Vicar of the Cathedral Parish effective 31 March 2013. My last Sunday in the Cathedral will be **24 February 2013** (due to leave owing).

I will have served as Dean of the Cathedral for almost nine years and it is time for the Cathedral to seek a new leader. The date of our departure is timed with a sabbatical which Stephen will be taking in the United States March – May 2013. Stephen is to be a Fulbright Scholar at the University of Georgetown in Washington DC where he will be undertaking a research project in his field of international trade. I have been granted a residency for part of this time at Virginia Theological Seminary and we will live at the Seminary in Alexandria.

On our return in June 2013 we will settle in either Auckland or Wellington to allow Stephen to expand his consulting business. I will then seek ministry opportunities in either city.

- ♦ approved the purchase of new computers for the Cathedral. The last upgrade was nine years ago and we have "saved up" for this in that time;
- ♦ began to discuss arrangements for the transition period as Dean Helen prepares to leave.

Vestry will meet again next week with the Vestry of St Augustine's to discuss closer co-operation between our parishes.
