Kohupātiki Marae has for over 100 years now made very bold statements of its faith in God with both its siting of a sanctuary inside 'Tane-nui-a-rangi' Meeting House - and its hosting of the Bishop of Aotearoa Bishop's Court for over 40 years.

Waipatu Marae similarly asserts a strong story of faith with "Little St Matthew's" and a substantial Māori Priest's vicarage on its grounds.

This is an opportunity to pilgrimage to both these Marae to hear their proud Māori Anglican stories ... Or parishioners are welcome to attend the 11.00am Holy Communion service at Kohupātiki Marae beforehand, followed by shared lunch.
