## APPOINTMENTS ... RESIGNATION

**Bishop Don Tamihere** will be installed as the sixth Pihopa o Aotearoa and Archbishop of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa, New Zealand and Polynesia, on **Saturday, 28<sup>th</sup> April**, at **Manutuke Marae**, near Gisborne. Powhiri at 8am, Service at 10am, followed by Hakari.

Bishop Justin Duckworth has announced that the **Rev'd David Rowe** has been appointed as Dean of Wellington Cathedral of St Paul. David is a UK priest currently serving as Priest-in-Charge of Christ Church, Winchester, England. He is due to commence his new role in July.

Archbishop Philip Richardson has appointed the **Rev'd Ross Falconer** to be Interim Dean of Taranaki Cathedral of St Mary following the retirement of Dean Peter Beck at Easter.

Bishop Andrew has announced that **Bruce Allport** will be appointed as Deacon-in-charge at St Peter's Riverslea Parish (Hastings) in July. Bruce is currently completing studies at St John's Theological College in Auckland and will be ordained Deacon in Waiapu Cathedral in July.

**Bishop Victoria Matthews** has announced her resignation from her role as Bishop of Christchurch, effective 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018.

The Cathedral Wardens and Vestry are pleased to announce the formal appointment of **Anthony Tattersall** as the Cathedral's Director of Music; and the appointment of **Gary Bowler** as Organist Emeritus; also the appointment of **Paul Anderson** as the Parish Treasurer; and the **Rev'd Jon Williams** has retired from the Ministry Team and now holds a 'Letter of Authority' from Bishop Andrew Hedge. Waipatu Marae similarly asserts a strong story of faith with "Little St Matthew's" and a substantial Māori Priest's vicarage on its grounds.

This is an opportunity to pilgrimage to both these Marae to hear their proud Māori Anglican stories.
